Launch & Haul Assistant

Hello TBYC Members,

As we get ready for launch this spring once again we are looking for volunteers to assist with the travel lift. Last year a small group of members put in a lot of time and effort, and the feedback from membership was very appreciative. This year the goal is to get even more members involved, gain experience with the lifting process, and be part of the volunteer effort that makes such a big difference to the operation of our club.

A Lift Assistant Sign Up will be created on the TBYC Website and those interested in participating will need to use this to schedule their involvement. There will be one spot available per lift day. The Assistant will be expected to arrive 15 minutes early to help with various duties, such as removing sling covers and lift inspection.

Safety is the number one priority during all lift operations and the Assistant will follow direction from the Operator at all times.

Compensation will be as follows:

- Each lift assist, up to 10 lifts, will be credited with 1 Full Volunteer Hour.
- All additional lift assists, or assists by members without a volunteer obligation, will be paid at \$10 per lift and credited to the member's account, or paid out by cheque at request of the member.
- All members are welcome to participate, but must be 16 years or older and be Full, Co-Owner, Associate, Social, or Racing Members in good standing with the Club.

The number of lifts performed each day varies according to how many boaters have scheduled a lift, so the length of day will also vary. If you are not able to stay the whole time that is fine, all help is welcome. Typically the busiest days are early and late season so if you are interested in fulfilling all of your hours in one go, then one or two days can achieve this.
